Excerpts from annual report by CECC, a body created by Congress with a legislative mandate to monitor human rights and rule of law in China. CECC consists of Senators, Members of the House of Representatives, and members of the Department of State, Department of Labor, and Department of Commerce. Provides up to date information (post-dating the Department of State’s 2007 Profile of Asylum Claims and Country Conditions) on family planning in China.

CECC report noting that family planning violators are “routinely punished with fines, and in some cases, **subjected to forced sterilization;**” “[I]ocal governments have in some cases **stepped up efforts** to impose penalties and fines against couples who give birth to an unauthorized child;” the use of **coercion measures . . . remain[] commonplace;**” notes that **Fujian officials are authorized to take ‘remedial measures’ to deal with ‘out-of-plan’ pregnancies**, and that abortion is an official policy instrument in Fujian Province; notes a **five-week campaign in Fujian Province in 2009** of “‘concentrated service activities’ that designated the ‘implementation of abortion remedial measures’ among its five ‘primary tasks.’ [Officials were authorized] to ‘adopt effective and comprehensive punitive measures and ensure that remedial measures against out-of-plan pregnancies are taken promptly and reliably.’” Township-level authorities in Fujian also urged officials to “strictly act on the demand to carry out tubal ligation within one month” for women who give birth to a second or third child.

Notes the Profile “**systematically omits documentation** which qualifies or disproves some of its claims. . . even though this documentation is public.” “The 2007 Report is **outdated**. Some sections were carried over from the 1998 to the 2004 Report, and from there to the 2007 Report.” “**Contradictory statements are apparent in the 2007 Report’s**

Initiates a family planning campaign during a holiday period when the ‘floating’ population of migrant workers returns home to ensure its compliance with family planning laws.

*\*On Assessment, Award and Punishment Methods for 2011 Annual Population and Family Planning Work*, Chang Le City Population and Family Planning Leadership Group Document (December 15, 2010)..... 303

Details the target management responsibility system in Changle, including points awarded and deducted based on meeting population targets and quotas (e.g. sterilization rate is 20 point), and monetary awards and penalties for family planning cadre (e.g., top township in annual assessment awarded RMB 100,000, while lowest penalized RMB 100,000).

EE. *\*Announcement on Diligently Implementing the Population and Family Planning Work in May, June and July*, Chang Le City Population and Family Planning Leadership Group Document (May 7, 2009)..... 314

Initiates a “**one-hundred day campaign**” for family planning, focusing on “remedial measures” and materializing long-term birth control methods; states that officials should “**avoid going through formality**” in carrying out their family planning work; also provides a “Guiding Index on Four Surgeries and Social Child Support Fees,” listing the targets and quotas for the family planning campaign.

FF. *\*Notice Regarding the Conducting of Major Citywide Family Planning Clean-Up Work*, Changle City Population and Family Planning Leadership Group Document (December 24, 2008)..... 334

Initiates a **family planning campaign** for all towns and villages in Changle at the turn of the new year in 2008-2009 to ensure that population targets are met, e.g., “the number of sterilization completed for persons with two daughters must be over 80% of the target assigned for the first half of the year;” the campaign time frame is chosen to take advantage of the “large number of departed workers return[ing] home for the New Year’s Day and the Spring Festival.”

*\*Shou Zhan Township Announcement on Efficiently Implementing Family Planning Work During the New Year and Spring Festival of 2009*, Chinese Communist Party Chang Le City Shou Zhan Township Committee (December 31, 2008).....346

Initiates a family planning campaign in Shouzhnan to ensure population targets are met for the year; urges family planning officials to go door-to-door to “**materialize measures**,” and sets population targets and goals and corresponding punishments and rewards associated with meeting the targets; **authorizes the use of force** to collect “social child support fees.”

*\*Shou Zhan Township Standards for Social Child Support Fee Collection*, Shou Zhan Township Population and Family Planning Leadership Group (December 26, 2008).....361

Calculates economic penalties for unauthorized births.

II. *\*New Types of Marriage, Childbearing and Policies*, Shou Zhan Township Population and Family Planning Leadership Group (December 1, 2008).....369

Describes standard family planning policy rules and penalties, including: “[a]fter having two children, **one of the couple is to be sterilized** whether the second child is a boy or a girl” and economic penalties consisting of two to three times an urban resident’s salary, or the average income of a rural resident’s income.

JJ. Affidavit of Flora Sapio regarding authenticity of government documents from Changle (Tabs EE, FF, GG & HH) (September 1, 2010).....377

KK.

*\*The Current Family Planning Policy and Policy of Birth Control Technology*, The Family Planning Committee of Ying Qian Town.....424

Provides “for a couple who has two children, at least one of the couple is **required to have sterilization**,” economic fines for a couple violating the policy by having an additional child is two to three times the aggregate income of the couple, and “much heavier fee” for additional children thereafter.

LL. *\*Q&A on the Basic Knowledge of Population and Family Planning of Ying Qian Town*, Family Planning Committee of Ying Qian Town..... 435

Provides that couples must have an “IUD placement after one child; **sterilization after two children**,” and in the case of an unwanted pregnancy, “immediately practice[] remedial measures.”

*\*Report on Jin Feng Township Family Planning Work*, Jin Feng Information, Jin Feng Township Party and Government Administrative Office 4/17/2009..... 443

\*includes evidence of counsel’s attempt to authenticate document

Provides that Jin Feng Township has been weak and “ranked the bottom few” in 2009, and so calls for intensification of family planning work, including sending out “hidden investigators,” reaching 70% materialization rate for sterilizations on families with two female children, “[s]trictly control extra births after having one boy,” and intensify the effect of rewards and penalties. Family planning leaders who cannot improve their work “will be suspended and they will be deposed.”

*\*Temporary Reward and Punishment Stipulations on Further Improvement of Family Planning Work Responsibilities*, Jin Feng Township Population and Family Planning Leadership Group (March 31, 2009). . . . . 455

Provides implementation plan for Changle’s target management responsibility system to “ensure the comprehensive fulfillment on the goals” set for 2009. Provides for monetary awards and penalties based on fulfillment of quotas and targets, and allows for suspension and termination of family planning leaders.

*\*A Few Stipulations on Further Enhancing the Standards for “Double Check-ups” Work*, Jin Feng Township Population and Family Planning Leadership Group (May 18, 2009). . . . . 469

Details the comprehensive monitoring of women (“targets”) in Jin Feng; all women under the age of 40 must have three pregnancy and birth control checkups a year; women whose husbands are permanent residents abroad must be checked once a year, unless the husband returns home, in which case they will have ‘normal’ checkups; overseas women will also be managed—if they return home they will also be required to have ‘normal’ checkups.

Provides progress on family planning work throughout Changle, including listing the number of sterilizations and abortions performed, and the required quotas for each township/neighborhood during the relevant time period.

Provides progress on family planning work throughout Changle, including listing the number of sterilizations and abortions performed, and the required quotas for each township/neighborhood during the relevant time period.

\*includes evidence of counsel’s attempt to authenticate document

Notes local policy requires IUD after one birth, and sterilization after two births; states that “[i]n each village, there are many Chinese women whom have given birth to two children in a foreign country. Regardless of whether their children have foreign nationality, those Chinese women are required to return to China and undergo sterilization operation. Unless they change their nationalities, then they may be exempt from sterilization.”

*\*Tantou Town’s Implementation of “Fighting Month” for Family Planning, Family Planning Leading Group of Tantou Town (December 18, 2009).....515*

Notes the new campaign, the “Fighting Month” for meeting family planning targets and quotas, includes a progress chart on meeting these goals, and notes that family planning officials will be rewarded or punished depending on their fulfillment of targets.

TT. *\*Tantou Town’s Implementation of “Fighting Month” for Family Planning, Family Planning Leading Group of Tantou Town (December 4, 2009).....525*

Notes the new campaign, the “Fighting Month” for meeting family planning targets and quotas, includes a progress chart on meeting these goals, and notes that family planning officials will be rewarded or punished depending on their fulfillment of targets, including sterilization operations for those with two children.

Details progress on the “**100-Day Battle**” to “firmly grasp the family planning work.” Notes “148 instances of lack of sterilization (including 42 instances of lack of sterilization after having two daughters),” and so provides that “[v]illages and residences. . . shall further strengthen consciousness of mission, increase esprits de

corps, **charge through the front lines, actively take all available measures, and fully facilitate the implementation of long-term contraceptive measures.**”

*\*Notification on Further Reinforcement of Family Planning Work*, Family Planning Office of Langqi Town, Langqi Economic District, Fuzhou City (Aug. 30, 2009) .....551

Addresses the issue of returning nationals, and states “[f]or overseas Chinese ‘backflow’ from abroad, who have ever given birth inside or outside of the country, **regardless whether or not their children have obtained foreign nationalities, all parents without exception are subject to our town’s family planning goals**, and will be managed by current family planning management measures.” “Women who are pregnant outside the plan, shall undergo [dilation and curettage] abortion or induced-labor abortion, and **if nature of violation is bad, ‘one party of the couple’ shall resolutely undergo sterilization.**”

Details a campaign to “work hard in one hundred days, fight the best battles, and comprehensively complete the second round population and family planning tasks in 2008;” provides that officials should “**continue to use escort service method to help materialize the remedial measures and long-term birth control methods such as ‘IUD installation for couples with only one child, sterilization for couples with two children;**” and details punishments for family planning violators and officials who fail to meet targets.

ZZ. *\*Announcement on Launching Countywide Massive Family Planning Clean-up Work, Lian Jiang County Population and Family Planning Leadership Group Document (December 24, 2010),.....* 580

Details a new family planning campaign “to stop the extra births beyond the quota” through strict adherence to ‘four surgeries,’ ‘social child support fees,’ and ‘double check-ups’ targets. Calls for entering homes to conduct a survey with emphasis on “the materialization rate” for four surgeries, stating “[t]ake every measure possible to raise the materialization rate.” The materialization rate for sterilization of families with two girls is 80% for the first half of the year. Officials who do not meet goals will face “great severities” and assessed as “not qualified for the jobs for that year and will also be disciplined in other ways.”

*\*Notification with regard to the Issues on Stepping Up the Work of the Hundred-Day Battle on Population and Family Planning Work, The People’s Government of Guantou Town (June 11, 2009),.....* 593

Details a family planning campaign, the “Hundred-Day Battle on population and family planning, complete the missions of required abortion, induced labor abortion, sterilization, and collection of social maintenance fees,” whereby officials must “[s]tep up the implementation of birth control measures. Provides for rewards and penalties depending on family planning progress.

BBB.

*\*Notification with regard to Tightening of this year’s Implementation of Birth Control Measures, The People’s Government of Guantou Town (March 16, 2008) .....* 601

Provides that officials must “step up your efforts on population and family planning, especially step up this year’s implementation of birth control measures and its long-term effects, **women with two ore more children are required to perform the sterilization.**”

CCC.

*\*Notification with regard to the Issues on Stepping Up the Implementation of the Population and Family Planning Policy, The People’s Government of Guantou Town (July 26, 2007) .....* 608

Requires family planning officers to “step up the implementation” of their work and “complete the missions of required birth induction, sterilization, and collection of social maintenance fees.” Provides “[i]f the target of induced labor abortion, sterilization, and collection of social maintenance fees is under control by other village, then the target’s local village will have to implement the missions of induced labor abortion, sterilization, and collection of social maintenance fees within 12 hours.”

Family planning officials that do not do so will be warned and fined. Individuals who have children born above the quota will be fined 2 to 3 times their annual disposable income.

*\*The Campaign of “Bringing the New Custom of Marriage and Child-bearing into Thousands of Households” in Guantou Town, Family Planning Publicity Materials, The People’s Government of Guantou Town ..... 617*

Provides that “women with two or more children are required to perform the sterilization,” and “[r]emedial measures should be taken for unauthorized pregnancies (such as abortion or induced labor abortion).”

EEE.

*\*Family Planning Promotion Booklet, Family Planning Council of Lianjiang, Family Planning Association of Lianjiang ..... 626*

Provides guidance on adhering to Fujian’s Family Planning Regulations, including penalties of 2 to 3 times total income for having more than one child, and stating that “ligation” is “to be used” after having two children.

FFF.

*\*Notification of Several Conference Issues Regarding the Solid Tackle of the Settlement of “Four Techniques” of Family Planning for Months of May, June, and July and of “Critical Remedial Measures,” Guantou Township Committee Document (May 10, 2007)..... 644*

Details a family planning campaign from May 1, 2007 to July 31, 2007, during which time villages must reach family planning targets; rewards and punishments for reaching these goals are also detailed, e.g., 50 yuan reward for completion of sterilization, while a 100 yuan fine is imposed for each ‘missing completion.’

*\*Notice of Establishing Special Operation Command for Family Planning One-Hundred Day Campaign to Clear Up Backlogs of “Four Surgeries” and to Implement “Critical Remedial Measures,” Guantou Township Committee Document (May 10, 2007)..... 653*

Establishes the commanding office structure to implement the “one hundred-day campaign,” including a “**Search and Arresting Group**,” whose major responsibility is to “search and arrest the rule breaker. **If women is confirmed to be pregnant without permit, send them to the County Hospital. Implement critical remedial measure.**”

HHH.

*\*Announcement of the Further Improvement of the Family Planning Work, Lianjiang County Guantou Township (December 27, 2005).....666*

Determining that “all the returning oversea Chinese, who do not have citizenships of other countries, shall follow the laws and regulations regarding family planning of the state and Fujian Province,” including family planning laws. Family planning policy includes, “[f]or those pregnant out of the plan, shall be aborted. One party of the couple shall be sterilized if the nature of the violation is very serious.”

III. *\*Tiangjiang Town Year 2009 Family Planning Work Report, Fuzhou City Mawei District Tingjiang Town People’s Government Document (December 1, 2009).....675*

Details quota and target figures for 2009, including number of ‘four procedures’ which includes sterilization and abortion operations; demonstrates local adherence to the target management responsibility system, with explicit reference to the “award and punishment” system. Provides that an “existing problem” is not perfectly fulfilling the four procedures quota.

Provides that a government worker who has an unauthorized pregnancy must be educated to terminate the pregnancy; if she fails to do so, she should be “**suspended from [her] jobs and will not receive wages until the pregnancy is terminated;**” for non-government workers, “the district, township, neighborhood committee and farm must take necessary administrative and economical measure.” Couples who give birth to an additional child out of plan must be fined two to three times their combined income for the year and return their government allotted plot of farm land.
